Art Fair Tokyo 2019
March in Tokyo Transforms into Month of Art
New Satellite Events at 3 Locations
Partnerships with 15 Art Museums, Including National Art Museums, and
Special Discounts on Admission
Discounted Pair Tickets, Student Discounts, and Late-Entry Passes on Sale
from November 14

Art Fair Tokyo 2019, the largest international art fair in Japan that takes place from March 7 to March 10, will hold its first satellite events concurrently with the fair at three locations around the city in Roppongi, Tennozu, and Haneda Airport.

In addition to the Lobby Exhibition Area of the Art Fair Tokyo 2019 venue that is open to the general public, the “Future Artists Tokyo” exhibition, which is organized in partnership with art colleges around Japan, and the “World Art Tokyo” exhibition, which introduces the next generation of international talent in association with embassies in Tokyo, will also take place at three satellite venues. In this way, the fair will expand from its home at the Tokyo International Forum to reach the art areas around Tokyo Bay.

From November 14, advance tickets for the fair go on sale. Along with Pair Tickets (1-Day Passes for two persons) that offer for a limited period a saving of ¥4,000 off the price of passes purchased on the day, tickets include the Tokyo Art Passport, a popular item last year that also allows admission to two partner events, the Late-Entry Pass, which allows admission on Friday night for just ¥500, and the Student 1-Day Pass, a new ticket concession that offers a generous discount for students.

Moreover, all 1-Day Passes for the 2019 fair provide discounts on admission at 11 of the fair’s 15 special supporter art museums.

In March, Tokyo will transform into a bustling city of art packed with satellite events in addition to the main fair itself.

Art Fair Tokyo 2019 Satellite Events at Three Locations: Roppongi,

Three satellite events held concurrently with Art Fair Tokyo 2019 will further boost the city as a destination for art this March.

The events will expand two exhibitions at the fair that take place within an area of the venue that is open to the general public: “Future Artists Tokyo,” which is organized in partnership with art and design colleges in Japan, “World Art Tokyo,” which introduces artists from other countries in association with their respective embassies in Tokyo. In this way, the fair and its satellite events form an exciting showcase of the next generation of artistic talent.

The satellite events will be held at three locations: Roppongi, a district where there are many galleries and art museums; Tennozu, an attractive waterfront area that has also developed as an art neighborhood; and Haneda Airport, which serves as the entrance from Tokyo to the skies. Alongside the highly ambitious students from art colleges, work by a wide range of artists from different countries will appear around the city. (Please note that these artworks will not be for sale like regular dealer or gallery exhibits at the fair.)

In addition, the fair will partner with 15 art museums as special supporters as well as two other concurrent art fairs in the city, ART in PARK HOTEL TOKYO 2019 and 3331 Art Fair 2019.

This coming spring, Tokyo will truly become a whole city of art.

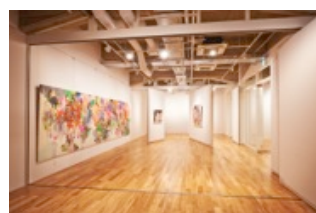
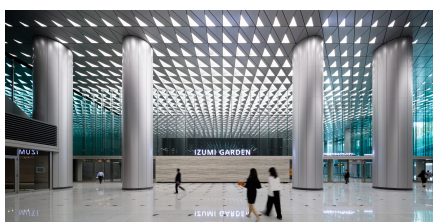

All 1-Day Passes Give Admission Discounts for 11 Special Supporter Art Museums!

Art Fair Tokyo 2019 will offer the Student 1-Day Pass (sold in advance only) for the first time. This helps students more easily experience an annual event that brings together such a diverse range of types of art, from antiques to crafts, Japanese-style painting, and modern and contemporary artworks.

At last year's fair, the Tokyo Art Passport was one of the most popular ticket categories. It offers ticketholders admission to three art fairs taking place concurrently around the city in the districts of Yurakucho, Shiodome, and Soto-Kanda. With just one pass, visitors can enjoy ART in PARK HOTEL TOKYO 2019 (March 9–10) and 3331 Art Fair 2019 (March 6–10) as well as Art Fair Tokyo 2019. Pair Tickets offer a saving of ¥4,000 off two tickets purchased the day. (On sale: Wednesday, November 14, 2018 at 10am – Sunday, February 10, 2019, at midnight)

Other special tickets also on sale from November 14 include the Late-Entry Pass, which allows ticketholders to visit the fair for just ¥500, and the 1-Day Pass Advance with Guided Tour, which includes a place on a guided tour with the Art Fair Tokyo tours director.

All 1-Day Passes sold at Art Fair Tokyo offer ticketholders special discounts or free admission at 11 art museums from the 15 venues that serve as special supporters of the fair. The special supporter venues participating in this special offer comprise nine in Tokyo (including the National Museum of Modern Art, Tokyo and the National Art Center), one in Gunma Prefecture, and one in Kanagawa Prefecture. Discounted admission at the POLA MUSEUM OF ART starts in December, while the Idemitsu Museum of Arts and Toguri Museum of Art offer discounts from January. This is an e-ticket purchased via a smartphone device. It offers a 1-Day Pass for the cheaper advance rate even if purchased on the day.

A special discounted ticket for junior high school, high school, vocational college, junior college, and university students.

Ticketholders may be required to show student ID when entering the venue.

Late-Entry Pass (March 8 only) ¥500 (incl. tax)

Ideal for casual visitors who want to enjoy art at night, this ticket allows admission during a 90-minute period (6:30–8pm).

Premium 4-Day Pass ¥12,000 (incl. tax) (available in limited numbers)

This pass allows admission during the three days of the fair's public viewing period as well as to the vernissage (Thursday, March 7, 4–8pm). It also comes with use of the Art Fair Tokyo Lounge, a copy of the catalogue for a previous fair, and an Art Fair Tokyo 2019 poster.

1-Day Pass Advance with Guided Tour (March 9 only) ¥4,500 (incl. tax)

An ideal ticket for first-time fair visitors or art "beginners," this pass also offers a guided tour led by the fair's tours director.

Over 150 galleries from Japan and overseas participate in the fair, offering works for display and sale in a wide variety of genres including antiques, crafts, Nihonga (Japanese painting), modern and contemporary art. During the event, there are historically significant Japanese art works on display as well as special exhibitions attempting to communicate the "now" of Tokyo's art scene and market, and related symposia and parties held at locations around the city. The international and diverse art market platform, ART FAIR TOKYO, is a place not only for art fans and art industry people, but also ambassadors from various countries, government officials, and business leaders to exchange information and engage socially.
