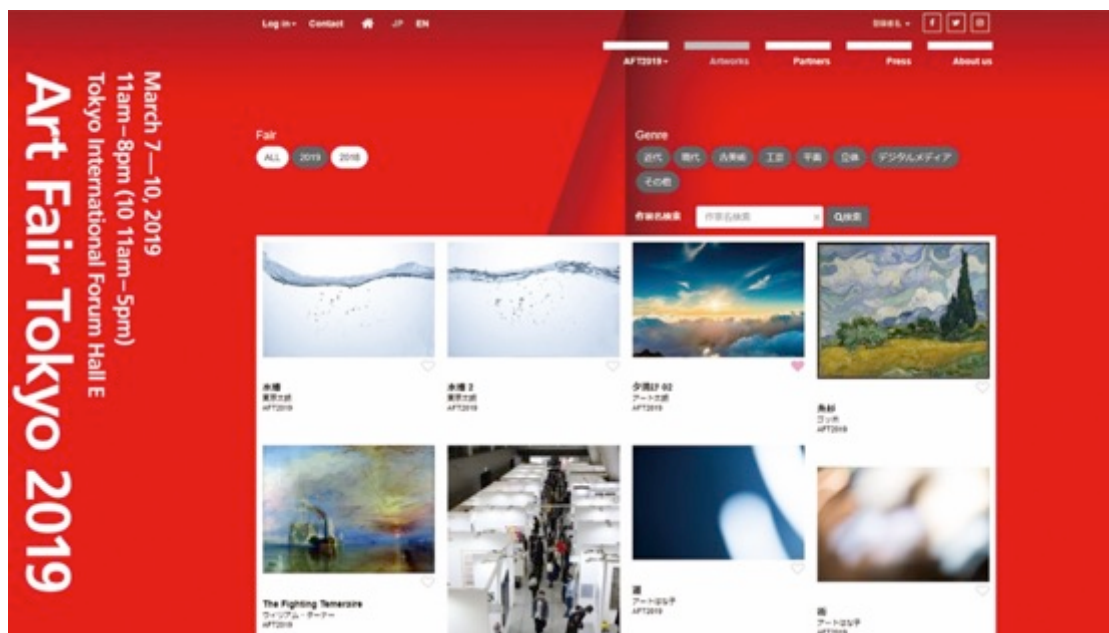
Artworks 2019 now up on the official website!

Since last year, the official ART FAIR TOKYO website has hosted the popular Artworks section, and the 2019 edition will go public on January 31 (Thu) from 6pm. "Artworks" is the place where exhibitors can show previews of works they plan to offer for sale at ART FAIR TOKYO. Find out what exhibitors are particularly excited about, learn about artists and their works in advance, and search for pieces by genre, artist, and exhibitor. There are links to individual exhibitor pages (within the AFT2019 site), so visitors can find their favorite artists and exhibitors, check the location of booths, and get basic information about exhibitors. New for this year, users can save favorite artworks and exhibitors to a "My Collection" list or make their very own personalized ART FAIR TOKYO 2019 map.

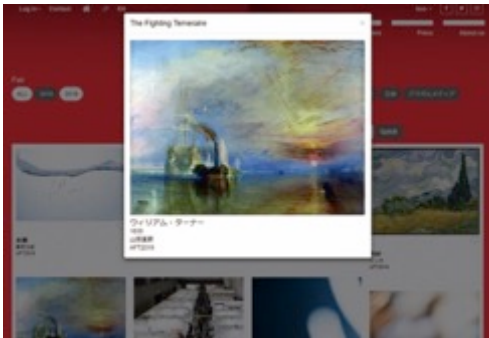

3. Exhibit names can be clicked to see individual pages for each exhibitor.



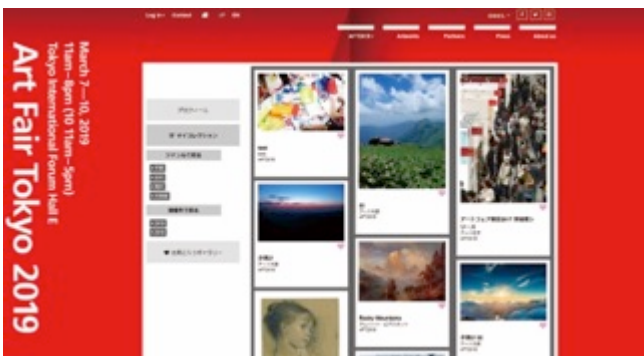
2. Detailed information on a pop-up page

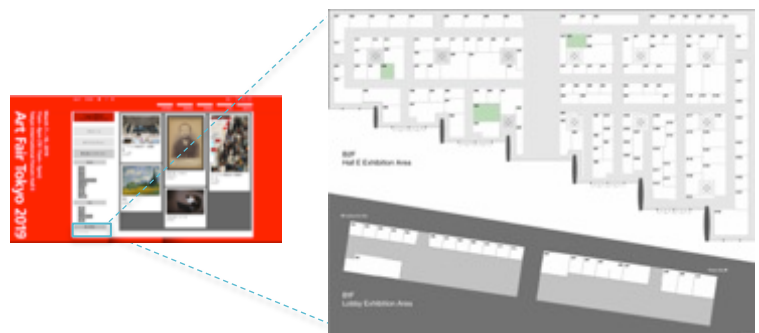


#### My Collection

### What is ART FAIR TOKYO?

ART FAIR TOKYO is the largest international art fair in Japan, held in Tokyo every spring. Over 150 galleries from Japan and overseas participate in the fair, offering works for display and sale in a wide variety of genres including antiques, crafts, Nihonga (Japanese painting), modern and contemporary art. During the event, there are historically significant Japanese art works on display as well as special exhibitions attempting to communicate the "now" of Tokyo's art scene and market, and related symposia and parties held at locations around the city. The international and diverse art market platform, ART FAIR TOKYO, is a place not only for art fans and art industry people, but also ambassadors from various countries, government officials, and business leaders to exchange information and engage socially.
