Art Fair Tokyo 2019 Fair Visitors Total Record Number of 60,717 Two Exhibitions in Free Admission Area Visited by Approx. 40,000 and 37,000

Art Fair Tokyo 2019 came to a successful close on March 10. Featuring 160 exhibitors from home and abroad, and supported by six Japanese government agencies including the Cabinet Office as well as 104 embassies, the fair attracted a record 60,717 visitors over four days.

The theme of the 2019 fair was "Art Life." Each exhibitor's booth contained elaborate and impressive displays of art that received a very positive response from fair visitors.

Held in the free admission lobby area of the fair venue, the exhibitions "World Art Tokyo: Vibrant Planet—If the world is our vibration," showcasing the work of overseas artists nominated by 31 embassies in Tokyo and curated by 31 students from Tokyo University of the Arts, and "Future Artists Tokyo: ERLection of Anonymous," produced and run by 45 students from 19 art universities around Japan, drew total visitor numbers of, respectively, 39,594 and 36,854.

Satellite fair events were held at three places around Tokyo, with visitors transported between the venues by a free shuttle bus service. In addition, partnerships with 15 art museums in the Kanto area as well as two other events helped transform Tokyo into a bustling city of art during March.
