101 galleries and art dealers from Japan and around the world showing alomst 2000 works, starting March 24 (Tue)

The Art Tokyo Association (Art Tokyo) has cancelled the international art trade fair, Art Fair Tokyo 2020 (AFT2020) (venue: Tokyo International Forum) that was scheduled to be held March 19 (Wed) to 22 (Sun), 2020 in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Starting from March 24 (Tue) to May 9 (Sat) Art Tokyo will hold a limited edition online gallery mall called "AFT Art Hunting" featuring exhibitors from AFT2020. Almost 2000 artworks including antiques, crafts, Nihonga (Japanese painting), modern and contemporary art are being presented with an exact price or showing inquiry botton, by more than 101 galleries and art dealers. Over a course of a month, "AFT Art Hunting" has attracted more than 340,000 visitors from the globe, creating opportunities for galleries and art dealers to communicate with interested parties, and providing opportunities to buy and sell artworks.

AFT Art Hunting is a new service developed using internet technology in order to expand the art market beyond venue-based art fairs. Art Tokyo that has been developing this for some time, and is its first initiative that uses internet technology. In recent years, art auctions have begun implementing internet technologies as art increasingly attracts attention as a highly-mobile asset that can be transported across countries and regions.

The movement of people has been severely restricted due to the global spread of COVID-19. In response to the cancellation of AFT2020, Art Tokyo has turned to the internet and established this new service in order to sell art online and reach new markets. Beyond AFT Art Hunting, Art Tokyo intends to continue expanding Japan's art market by making use of the many possibilities afforded by the internet.

AFT Art Hunting, established by AFT2020, of which this year's theme was "with Art"

"AFT Art Hunting" features over 2000 works of art, from historically significant works such as pottery, antiques from East Asia, and impressionist master works, to rising stars of the contemporary art including painting, sculpture and photography from Japan and further field.

Through almost 300 years of self-imposed isolation and embracing Western art, culture and technology in the 20th century, it's widely known that Japanese artists were influenced by modern art, but at the same time these artists created their own style while keeping to tradition. Whereas, 19th century European Impressionist artists were greatly influenced by their exposure to the Japanese print includes prints and drawings.

Back into Japanese art history and you may see a long tradition of using nature, religion and East-Asian philosophies as subjects, from Japanese paintings and potteries to well-known Japanese avante-garde movements *Gutai* and *Mono-ha*, postmodern art movement *Superflat*, which makes Japanese artworks radically different to anything outside the country's borders.

View art, buy art, and live with art. Under the "with Art" theme set for AFT2020, Art Tokyo has created a platform to expand the art market fusing diverse values to build a way for art to continue in a sustainable manner.


