## Announcing the End of ART FAIR TOKYO 2017

After four busy and successful days, ART FAIR TOKYO 2017 closed on March 19th.

Featuring 150 galleries from Japan and overseas as well as the support of the Cabinet Office, various government ministries, local governments and 65 embassies, a record number of 57,800 visitors attended the fair and preview the four-day period.

Themed around “Art is Alive: Getting Closer to Art, Art Getting Closer,” the fair and its various programs and events received a favorable response from visitors.

We would like to express our deep gratitude to everyone who helped make the fair a success.

The next fair is planned for March 8th to March 11th, 2018.

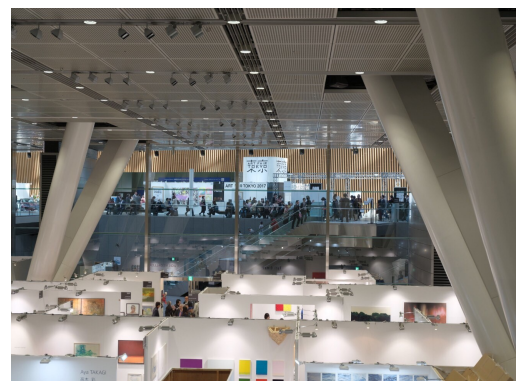
